

EOARC Net Script

Good evening, everyone! This is _____ with the weekly Eastern Ozarks Amateur Radio Club net. This net meets each Monday at 7:00 p.m. here on the Farmington repeater at 147.030 MHz with a PL of 100.

The purpose of this net is to report weather conditions, and pass traffic. At this time, we'll stand by for any emergency, priority, routine, or time-valued traffic.

(LISTEN FOR TRAFFIC)

Not hearing any traffic, we will continue on with the net. Should the need arise, we will relinquish control of the repeater and provide any assistance possible.

When checking in, please give your call sign, first name, and location slowly please.

Do we have any stations with announcements for the net?

(Check in any announcements)

Do we have any mobile, portable, or short-time stations?

(Note any of those stations)

Do we have any Echolink stations? If so, please allow about 10 seconds for the Echolink to connect.

(Note those stations)

We will now take regular check-ins. Again, please give your call sign, first name, and location slowly please.

(Process check-ins, and go back to the top of the list for comments – ask how things are going, general rag chew)

(After a run through of check-ins, ask a couple of more times for late check-ins and comments)

Not hearing any more check-ins, we will now go ahead and secure the net and return the repeater back to normal usage. You are invited to attend the monthly meeting of the Eastern Ozarks Amateur Radio Club on the second Saturday of the month at 2 p.m. at the Bonne Terre Airport, as well as the St Francois Co ARES meeting on the second Monday of the month at 8 p.m. also at the airport.

You are also invited to check into the ARES net, which follow this net at 7:30 p.m., and the Mineral Area Bible Study net on Tuesday Evenings at 7 p.m.
